General Contractor A:

This license shall entitle the holder thereof to perform work as a contractor while building, remodeling, and adding to or repairing any structure or addition thereto that is residential, non-residential, multi-residential, and all commercial as defined in the most current edition of the International Code Council's, Building Code adopted as the Building Code of the City of Junction City, Kansas.

General Contractor B:

This license shall entitle the holder thereof to perform work as a contractor while building, remodeling, and adding to or repairing any structure or addition thereto that is residential, non-residential, multi-residential, and all commercial under three (3) floors above grade as defined in the most current edition of the International Code Council's, Building Code adopted as the Building Code of the City of Junction City, Kansas.

General Contractor C:

This license shall entitle the holder thereof to perform work as a contractor as defined in this article while building, remodeling or repairing a structure or addition thereto that is a one- or two-family dwelling or a townhouse, defined in the most current edition of the International Code Council's, Building, Residential and property Management Code adopted as the Building Code of the City of Junction City, Kansas.

General Contractor D:

This license shall entitle the holder thereof to perform work as a contractor while building, remodeling, and adding to or repairing any structure or addition thereto that is residential, non-residential, multi-residential, and all commercial under three (3) floors above grade as defined in the most current edition of the International Code Council's, Building Code adopted as the Building Code of the City of Junction City, Kansas.

General Contractor E:

This license shall entitle the holder thereof to perform work as a contractor while building, remodeling, repairing or adding to any structure or addition as defined in the most current edition of the International Code Council's, Residential and Building Code adopted as the Building Code of the City of Junction City, Kansas. Thereto that is a one- or two-family dwelling or a townhouse.

Contractor, Specialty:

A contractor whose operations as such are the performance of construction work requiring special skill and whose principal contracting business involves the use of specialized building trades or crafts.
